Trader Parking Permit Commercial / Activity Centres

Using your permit

- 1. The permit must be displayed so that the entire document is clearly visible to an authorised Council officer.
- 2. The permit must be displayed on the left hand side of the vehicle dashboard.
- 3. The permit is not valid beyond the specified expiry date.
- 4. This permit is not transferable.
- 5. Permits do not guarantee the availability of parking in the permit zone.
- 6. Permits are only to be used private / commercial vehicles and are not authorised for large, or heavy vehicles, caravans, boats or trailers.
- 7. Permit fees may apply to your permit.
- 8. You must comply with all road rules during the use of your permit.
- 9. You can only use your permit in the location which has been specified on your permit.
- 10. If misuse of a permit is detected, or evidence is supplied which is false or misleading during the application process, the permission can be suspended or revoked by an authorised officer of Council.
- 11. The use of a commercial parking permit is not permitted on an unregistered vehicle.

Lost, stolen or damaged permits

12. Lost permit must be reported to Council or your traders association within 24 hours. Replacement permits will be considered after receipt of a statutory declaration.
