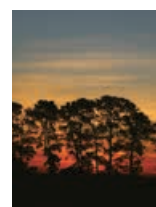

MESSAGE FROM OUR MAYOR



Our advocacy campaigns during the build up to the recent Federal election have delivered some significant outcomes – but this is just the start. With the build up to the State election in November we will once again be loudly representing your priorities and will be asking for your help.

Council have been advocating for many years to secure a youth mental health facility in Manningham. Our recent campaign for a headspace service has resulted in a federal budget funding commitment of \$1m for a service in our area. We welcome this announcement and will continue to advocate that the service is based in Manningham where we know it is most needed. We know that our young people have been asking for access to a local service for far too long. Having to travel up to two hours each way and wait for six months to get an appointment is unacceptable.

In addition to this there was a commitment of up to \$10m to fix the dangerous 'The Fiveways' intersection along Ringwood-Warrandyte Road. The compelling community feedback we received through our recent campaign has resulted in promised support as part of the federal election. As this is a State owned road we now need to keep fighting to ensure the road is fully funded and completed.

Our focus has now shifted to the upcoming State election, and we will be calling on your help to let candidates our communities priorities, and the list is significant!

For instance you've told us that transport and roads are important. We are focused on a number of major road projects, including finalising the design of Jumping Creek Road and the duplication of the State owned Templestowe Road. We are calling on State Government support to improve safety on these important roads.

Easy movement around our great municipality isn't all about roads. As we are all too aware, Manningham is public transport disadvantaged, and amongst many public transport priorities we need urgent action to ensure the Doncaster Busway is delivered.

We are calling for a commitment from the State government to improve our failing public transport and deliver the Doncaster Busway as well as other public transport priorities. Stay tuned.

Another initiative high on Council's agenda is affordable housing and the important role Council has in advocating for a safe home for everyone in our community. Homelessness affects the most vulnerable, including women and children fleeing domestic violence, people with a disability, people living with a mental health condition, people living in poverty and other marginalised groups. Some people think homelessness is not an issue in Manningham, yet the 2016 Census showed we had an estimated 3,390 households in rental stress, social housing or homelessness. The pandemic has only increased the pressure on our vulnerable communities. We need assistance from the State Government to stimulate funding that supports registered housing services to work in partnership with Council to help our community with safe and affordable housing.

What can you do?

On your behalf, we will be launching a campaign in the coming months asking for commitments from State election candidates to support our community. We will be asking you to support the campaign and encouraging you to reach out to candidates and members of parliament and add your voice.

A new app is giving you access to the Whitehorse Manningham Library Service in the palm of your hand.

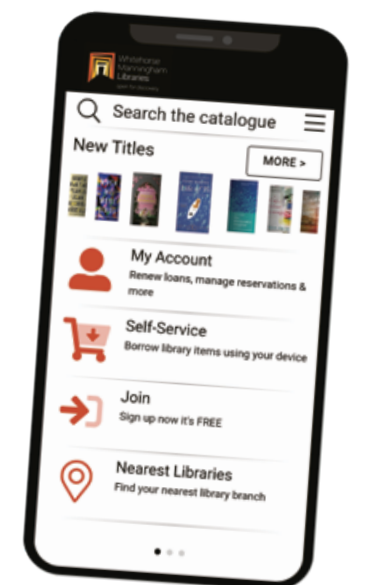
Once you have your library card and download the app, you can:

You can find an amazing variety of quality handmade Australian art and crafts at the gallery.

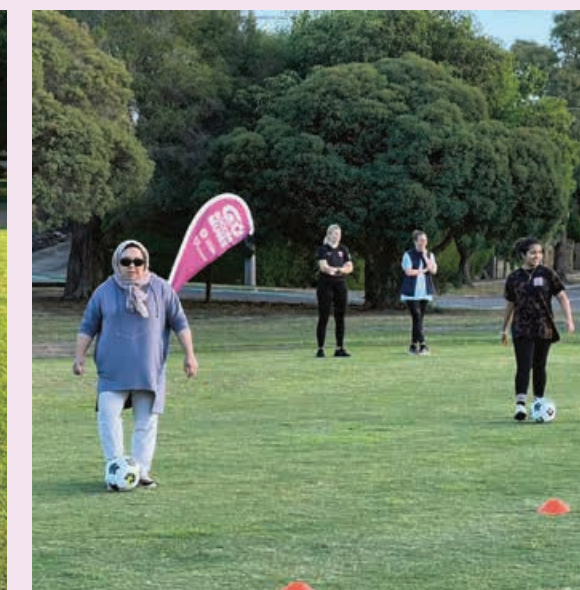

GO SOCCER MUMS

A new soccer program in Manningham is seeing women of Muslim faith get together to learn new skills and form new friendships.

GO Soccer Mums is an introductory football program designed specifically for women, but you don't have to be a mum to join in the fun. It doesn't matter if you have never kicked a football before - absolutely no experience is necessary.

Participants have been having fun, meeting new people, and learning basic football skills in a social, judgement free environment.

While we all know exercising is important for our physical and mental health, half of us aren't doing enough each week. In particular, women often face barriers to participating in physical activity, due to lack of time, cultural practices, clothing, feeling judged and self-conscious. Twice as many women than men put off getting active because they're worried about what other people think.*

GO Soccer Mums is an initiative of Football Victoria proudly supported by VicHealth's Reimagining Health Grant. Council partnered with Football Victoria and Macedon United Football Club to run the program.

BUILDING A BETTER MANNINGHAM: Focus on footpaths

Much of the work you see us doing around Manningham is construction and maintenance of footpaths and shared trails. We're proactively promoting walking and cycling.

These works, both major and minor, happen year round and are a key service for our community.

Here are some projects we have been working on.



1. James Street, Templestowe

A new footpath connection that joins James Street to the Ruffey Trail, the new Swilk Street playground and surrounding streets.

Completion date: March 2022.

2. Ringwood-Warrandyte Road, Park Orchards

Footpath construction along the arterial road between Milne Road and the bus stop allowing a safe pedestrian connection for bus passengers and the adjacent properties.

Completion date: February 2022.

3. Heidelberg - Warrandyte Road (Sunset Avenue to Innisfallen Road), Templestowe

Path on Heidelberg Warrandyte Road (arterial road) connecting the side streets and linking to the Newmans Road Shops

Completion date: May 2022.

4. Porter Street (Templemore Drive to road closure), Templestowe

Footpath creating a safe pedestrian access along the road and connection to the neighbouring streets and Green Gully Linear Park.

Completion date: May 2022.

5. Porter Street (Newmans Road to 326 Porter Street), Local Footpath, Templestowe

Continuation of Porter Street path.

Completion date: May 2022.

6. Webb Street (David Street to shops), Warrandyte

Footpath connecting Yarra Street to David Road allowing safer pedestrian access for residents to nearby shops, buses and Yarra Trail.

Expected completion date:

June 2022.

7. Springvale Road, Donvale

Footpath along arterial road connecting local residents to buses, Mullum Mullum Reserve, Stadium and Trail. Current sections include from Reynolds to Pine Hill Drive and Mitcham Road to Old Warrandyte Road.

Expected completion date: July 2022.

8. McGowans Road, Donvale

Footpath along McGowans Road from Springvale Road to Flora Road, connecting residents to buses and shops.

RECYCLING YOUR E-WASTE

The Victorian Government banned e-waste from going to landfill in 2019, because of the environmental damage it causes. Most e-waste contains valuable materials which are recyclable.

E-waste contains hazardous materials, like lead, mercury and cadmium, which we can work together to keep out of landfill.

You can dispose of larger e-waste items by booking a hard waste collection if you have a Council residential waste service or by dropping off the items at your closest recycling centre.

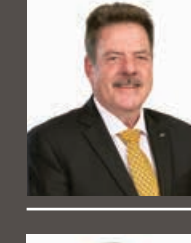

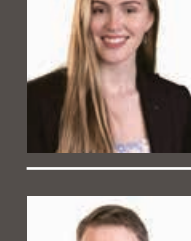

Supporting youth mental health

Young people in Manningham are demanding access to a local youth mental health service.

A commitment of \$1 million per year for four years will be provided for a headspace service in the Menzies/Chisholm area, concentrated in Doncaster, Box Hill and Box Hill North. headspace is a non-profit Australian organisation providing mental health services to 12-25 year-olds. This commitment has come about following years of advocacy by Council and the Community.

However it is not over yet! We need a commitment for a service in Manningham as that is where we believe the demand is greatest and the impact most beneficial

FACTS

- In the past year, local demand for youth mental health support has grown by 48%
- Suicide is the leading cause of death for our 15-24 year olds. The cost of not responding to this crisis in our community could be catastrophic
- Manningham's closest headspace offices have a three to six month wait for services
- If our young people wish to access a headspace service, they face travel times of up to 80 minutes.



We are still campaigning to raise awareness of the lack of youth mental health facilities in Manningham and act as a case study for the community's demand for a headspace.

We're working with local young people, the Manningham Youth Advisory Committee, schools, sporting centres and community centres, to develop and deliver a range of advocacy activities.

We're also looking for suitable activity suggestions from our community, so if you have a great idea, we encourage you to contribute to the campaign.
