MESSAGE FROM OUR MAYOR



Welcome back to our first issue of *Manningham Matters* for 2023. I hope you had some time over the holidays to rest and recharge and are looking forward to the exciting year ahead as much as I am.

We ended 2022 with a bang – around 10,000 people attended our Carols by Candlelight, making it our biggest Carols ever! I loved seeing so many smiling faces singing along and getting to meet many of you.

At the start of December we also celebrated the 10 year anniversary of MC Square. Since it opened in 2012, the building and forecourt have been a community hub – bringing us together for celebrations and to access so many fantastic services in one location. On the same day, we relaunched our Doncaster Hill Community Garden; I encourage you to wander down and check it out the next time you're in the area. See pages 4 and 5.

As we look ahead, there are plenty of special dates to pop in your calendars! On Sunday 5 March, I'll be rolling up my sleeves to take part in Clean Up Australia Day. We'll be hosting three clean up events across Manningham – at Warrandyte River Reserve, Ruffey Lake Park, as well as Lawford Reserve and Tullamore Parklands. We'll provide you with gloves and litter collecting gear. I hope you'll come along and help keep our beautiful city clean! You can find out more on page 3.

Wednesday 8 March will see the return of our International Women's Day morning tea. We'll celebrate with a panel discussion about this year's theme 'Cracking the Code: Innovation for a gender equal future'. See our events calendar on page 12 for more details.

We're getting excited for the launch of our new Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) service. From July, you will be able to place food waste into your existing green lid bin (with your garden waste) to be recycled into compost.

FOGO is an important step towards reducing the amount of waste that is sent to landfill in Victoria. Removing food waste from residential garbage bins in Manningham is expected to divert up to 20,000 tonnes of waste per year from landfill. Once FOGO starts, your green lid FOGO bin will be collected weekly and your red lid garbage bin will be collected fortnightly.

If you live in Manningham and have a residential waste service, you'll soon receive your FOGO kit. Your kit includes a FOGO kitchen caddy and a roll of compostable liners to help you collect and carry your food waste out to your green lid FOGO bin. Learn more on pages 8 and 9.

Celebrating a decade of bringing our community together

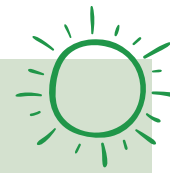
Since it opened 10 years ago, the MC Square building and forecourt have brought our community together. The space is a hub for community services and activities.

Since 2012, MC Square has been an accessible community centre, providing a wide range of organisations in one location. Sitting on top of Doncaster Hill, the precinct encourages community interaction and participation in learning, culture and the arts.

You can find various services including health, education, welfare, community, arts, cultural and heritage.

The building often hosts community events, including pop up parks, markets, gallery exhibitions and outdoor cinemas. It also played host to many celebrations – including Reconciliation and NAIDOC week, Chinese Lunar New Year, Persian New Year and International Peace Day.

DID YOU KNOW? If you're looking for somewhere to meet or work outdoors, new community seating has recently been installed and includes solar powered workstations.



In December last year, MC Square was abuzz with almost 2,000 people turning out to celebrate the building's 10 year anniversary.

There were vibrant activities for the whole family, including performers, market stalls, art workshops and games.

At the event, Mayor, Councillor Deirdre Diamante, reflected on how the building and its tenants brought our community together.

"For the past 10 years, it's been wonderful to see this space serve so many functions for people in our community. People of all ages and abilities come here to access the programs, activities and services, available all in one place.

I'd like to thank our MC Square tenants and their teams for your work over the past 10 years. You have provided services that improve the wellbeing and livelihood of our community.

The architecture of MC Square helps us to see the potential of a building and public space but it is the people who bring life to the building and surrounding spaces, so thank you to our Manningham community who have made MC Square a special place."



Have you seen our Community Garden lately?

At the MC Square anniversary event, Mayor, Councillor Deirdre Diamante, was joined by special guest, Jane Edmanson from *Gardening Australia*, to relaunch the Doncaster Hill Community Garden.

The garden relaunch unveiled a new shed, complete with stunning mural by artist, Ashala by Rebekah Paige, and veggie boxes made from (80%) plastic recycled by local residents.

Originally established in 2015, the garden has provided a space for locals to come together, share ideas, learn new skills, make friends and contribute to our community. For many people who live on Doncaster Hill, this space has become their backyard.

Over 80 volunteers have worked in the garden growing healthy produce to donate to Doncare's emergency pantry, which is vital for members of our local community who are struggling to access fresh food. So, next time you pop into MC Square, be sure to take a walk around and enjoy the garden!

New Bulleen sporting precinct

A new sporting precinct will welcome many enthusiastic local soccer players next year and unlock passive open space and access to Yarra River frontage for the wider community.

Located at 27-59 Templestowe Road in Bulleen, it will feature three soccer fields and a sports pavilion. It will also provide pedestrian and cycling access to open space areas for recreation.

Council was instrumental in negotiating a commitment from State Government to deliver this facility in response to the North East Link's impact to our community facilities at Bulleen Park.

Development Victoria will deliver the project as part of the North East Link Program. Construction will start in early 2023, with the soccer fields ready for kick off in 2024.

It's time: Getting ready for FOGO

Your Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) service is now just a few months away and we want to help you get ready to FOGO.

From July you will be able to place food waste into your existing green lid bin with your garden waste for it to be recycled into compost. You won't need a new bin, once FOGO starts, your current green lid garden bin will become your FOGO bin.

Going FOGO and removing food waste from red lid garbage bins in Manningham is a great way we can all reduce our emissions and divert waste away from landfill.

Once FOGO starts your green lid FOGO bin will be collected weekly and your red lid garbage bin will be collected fortnightly.

WHAT CAN GO IN YOUR FOGO BIN

If you can eat it or it grew in the ground, it **will be able** to go in your green lid FOGO bin from July.

You **cannot** place tea bags, food packaging, biodegradable products, clam and oyster shells, animal waste or cat litter into your green lid FOGO bin.

Between March and May we'll be delivering a FOGO starter kit directly to your doorstep to help you get going.

Your starter kit will include a FOGO kitchen caddy, a roll of compostable liners and an information pack with everything you need to help you get started.

Join us on a free tour of the Bio Gro organics facility which will recycle Manningham's food and garden waste into compost.

This is a great chance to see first-hand how your food and garden waste will be processed and ask any questions along the way.

MC SQUARE CLADDING REPLACEMENT

You may notice MC Square looks a bit different from February, when work to replace the external aluminium composite panel cladding begins. Scaffolding will remain in place around the building for the duration of the works which are expected to take around a year to complete. Helping you save with solar

Do you have solar power or are considering making the switch? Have you thought about installing a battery too?

A battery allows you to store excess electricity generated by solar panels for use when the sun isn't shining.

A battery storage system can:

- Help reduce your reliance on electricity from the grid.
- Allow you to capture excess solar energy that would normally be sent to the grid so you can use it later in the day.
- Offset the increased cost of power used during peak times.
- Save money by storing energy from the grid overnight when prices are low, to use during peak times when prices are high (depending on your power agreement).
- Provide electricity to your home during power outages (depending on your system).
- Reduce your exposure to future electricity price rises.

We now have a limited number of subsidies available through the Solar Savers Program. This program can help you install quality and affordable rooftop solar and batteries. The subsidy is available for the installation of battery system either by itself or as part of a solar installation through the Solar Savers program.

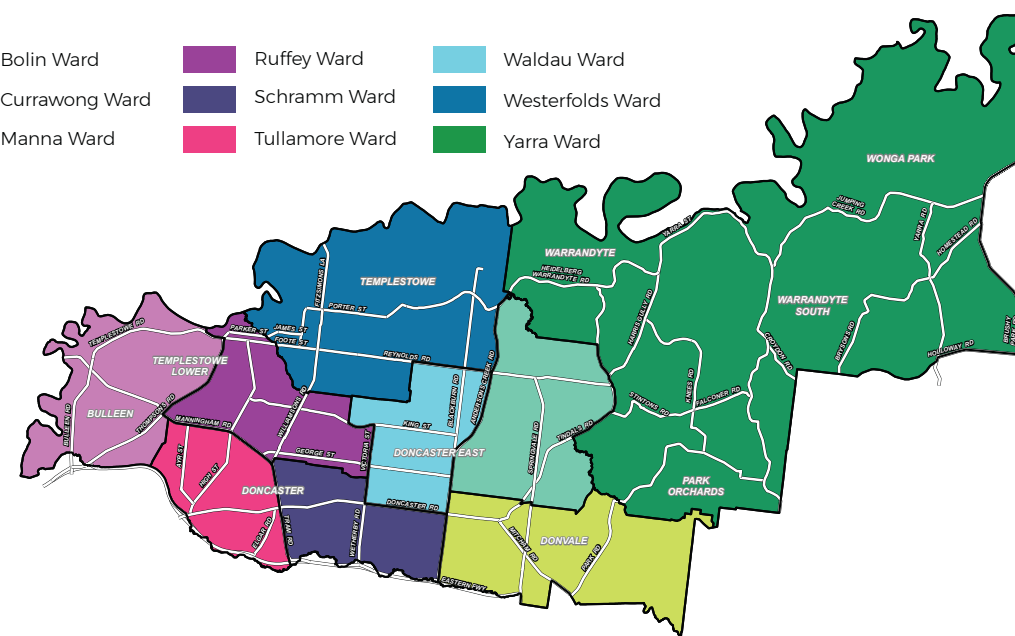

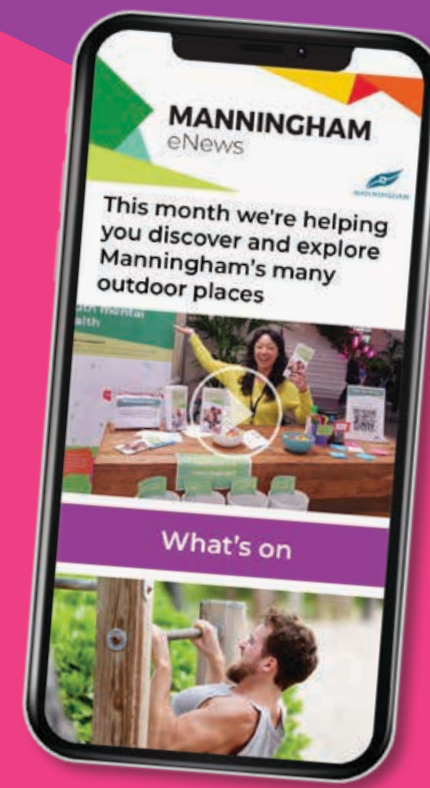
